

The Right to Waive Your Rights

"Let's part company. If you go to the left, I'll go to the right; if you go to the right, I'll go to the left." Genesis 13:9

For more than a year, Westsiders wrestled with the question, "What's God revealed to you about yourself?" Remarkably, the question stopped many cold. For the person who does not know Christ, the question is beyond their grasp. As for the Christian, it's another matter. Both think they have a handle as to how well or how poorly they reacted to the 2020 shutdown. And both imagine they have a handle as to how well or poorly their neighbors reacted. And yet, many Christians can't seem to grasp what God is revealing to them personally. I think, this is the most important question facing sincere believers today. For those who claim the Spirit of Christ, the question demands an answer! And the same can be said of the local church.

So, "What has God revealed to you about yourself?" Here are several insightful responses, "I'm more fragile than I thought." In other words, while the shut-down caught everyone off guard, one mature lady wisely realized her relationship with Christ is susceptible to attack. Another said, "I don't like who I've become." Here, God's revealing how abnormally attached this middle-aged disciple is to the fickleness of a fallen world. It's as if the old man surfaced, "I'mm Baack!" Finally, "I'm surprised how forgetful I am." Like the Apostle Peter, having experienced the presence of Christ, at the first blush of conflict, he abandoned his post. And frankly, I think the same can be said for the church. In addition, the church has an added responsibility. Here are just a few ways we're working to help you build the Body of Christ.

- 1. Joyfully waive your rights to yourself and let God choose for you. Abraham did it and so can we. This discipline is one in which the natural life is transformed into the life of obedience to the voice of God, in Word and Spirit.
- 2. Understand, Good is always the enemy of the Best. Many do not go on spiritually because we prefer sharpening our critical skills rather than relying on God to lead.
- 3. Learn to walk according to the highest standard which keeps its eye on God. As you devote yourself to God you're investing in the well-being of the Body!

Last "Times" (April 29th) we noted the expression, "Life is a Journey." This is the attitude in which we navigate the temporary depths, rough seas, and uncertainties of life. No doubt about it, we just survived a doozy of a storm. But, we did it together! Not perfectly, but together! 
