

## What is God Revealing to the Church?

"If you have raced with men on foot and they have worn you out, how will you compete with horses? If you stumble in the safe country, how will you manage the thickets by the Jordan?" (Jeremiah 12:5)

For more than a year, Westsiders' have wrestled with the question, "What's God revealed to you about yourself during the 2020 shut-down?" The question still baffles some, others simply have moved on and yet some hear God speak through the storm! People are listening! Perchance is it time the church is put to the task, "What has God shown us about the church, generally and specifically?" This is what I think God is saying, "Your faith is real... but untested." It's time the church heed Jeremiah's, not so subtle, warning. Let's examine the church.

#### An Honest Look at the Church

The local church needs to examine herself. Is it possible, the collectivecongregational faith, though commendable, is drifting towards a shipped-wrecked faith akin to the church in Ephesus (Revelation 2:2-4)? The church in Ephesus was mightily blessed. The people prospered. They were making a difference in the Kingdom of God, "Yet..." (v.4). If the passage is unfamiliar or you need a refresher, STOP. Set the TIMES aside and read Revelation 2:1-7. Although, their deeds were commendable, their attachment (love) to Christ was drifting towards the stuff the world recommends. When Christ is the Church's First Love, people prosper and nations flourish.

#### An Honest Look at Your Faith

What's God revealed to you about yourself? The Church? Join me in weighing our faith. Self-Examination is not simple. If we learned anything the last 18 months I fear, we've become experts at removing splinters and missing the timbers (Luke 6:41-42). Paul thinks the issue is so important that he concludes his letters to the Church in Corinth with a warning, "Test yourselves to see..." (2 Cor. 13:5). How can we see clearly if we are not willing, or unable, to examine ourselves? Oswald Chambers writes, "The only way to have spiritual understanding is through obedience." No one ever receives a word from God without immediately being put to the test over it. We disobey and then wonder why we don't go on spiritually. Furthermore, the Spirit of Christ exhumes the spirit of self-vindication; He makes us sensitive to things we never thought of before. Even at the risk of being thought fanatical when God speaks, obey (John 7:17). We're made to worship, together, in the Body of Christ, the church (1 Peter 1:13-25). See you Sunday.
