

"Therefore, I urge you brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing God – this is your true..." Romans 12:1-21

"The longer I live, the more I realize the impact of attitude on life. Attitude, to me, is more important than facts.
