



Test Me in This...

Lives are turned upside down - inside out. Overnight, once solid families, nations, even churches are in tatters. Strong relationships seem but a vapor. The division isn't just local, it's global! Well-meaning souls strive for unity but in practice create a darker version of humanity... uniformity. The world may only grouse around in the confusion, how may believers rise above the hatred as instruments of healing? Here are 3 simply encouraging truths.

Christ is the Culprit

Doctor's know the correct diagnosis is paramount for administering good medicine. You may be surprised our topsy-turvy world is not the devil's fault. Oh, the devil's thrilled to see us stumble. But Satan and his gleeful minions are not the root cause of our distress. Nor is the "opposing party" the root of our misery (I pray you're not deceived). Yes, evil is afoot but the central reason for our division is foretold in Scripture. Christ is behind this business of "shaking," "Once more I will shake not only the earth... (See Haggai 2 and Hebrews 12:26). When believers realize Christ is actually behind the shaking, we can take good medicine.

Christ is the Cure

Healing begins in your heart. To be an instrument of healing in our families, churches and even our nation, we must address the division within our own soul (Matthew 6:24). How? Above all, take Jesus at His Word (John 14:15-21). If your faith is real let Christ test you in the midst of His great shaking.

- a) Forgive the Unforgiveable. The negative consequences of not forgiving has been documented in studies that show it can lead to emotional pain, anger, hate, resentment, bitterness and ultimately create health issues. But even these distressing symptoms pale in comparison to the dire warning Jesus gives (Matthew 6:15). Genuine forgiveness is not just difficult, but impossible apart from the healing touch of Christ. Forgive.
- b) Love the Unlovable. The negative consequences of withholding love are disastrous. John 15:2 states that this love is not based on inclinations, "Love each other as I have loved you." 1 Peter 4:8 reveals love's power, "love covers a multitude of sins." 1 John 4:8 states His love is visible. "Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love."
- c) Risk your Reputation. 1 Corinthians 1:22-25 shatters all misconceptions or objections we may have to Christianity. The high of cost of Christ's company in the church is dear. The world will not, cannot understand His church and His people. Will you?
