

The Church Militant

Love Like a Christian (John 15:9-17)

The term *militant* describes the nature of the church Christ had in mind when he said, "church." Believers by nature are militant (Matthew 5:38-48). Likewise, the church's collective deep-seated love in the risen Savior is militant (Matthew 16:18). In fact, if you're not quick to exercise unconditional love, not quick to forgive, and not quick to freely serve, I question if you know Jesus at all. So how does the church militant live love in a sinful world (Mark 12:30-31)? My list is not exhaustive but here are a few ways that may help you get started.

Above All, Face the Truth (John 15:18-19)

The one thing the world cannot tolerate is agape love (v.18). Unconditional Christ-Love mocks the humanist idol of self-determinism. Since the Fall, Christ's radical love offends a sin-filled world (Genesis 3:15). Like it or not, the church is in a spiritual battle. To love like a Christian means the world hates those gathered in Jesus' name (church). Good intentions never pacify evil, "If you were of the world, the world would love you as its own" (v.19). So how do we remain faithful to Christ? Again, my list is not exhaustive but try to develop a few Heavenly-Habits.

Habit #1 Get in the Habit of Enjoying the Disagreeable – 2 Corinthians 4:11

To love like a Christian, means to manifest the life of Christ no matter how disagreeable a situation may be, "Lord, I am delighted to obey you in this matter." You cannot keep yourself fit if you're a slave to self-pity. Get in the habit of exhibiting the joy of letting God have His way.

Habit #2 Get in the Habit of Prosperity – 2 Peter 1:4

"Oh, we can't afford it," is one of the worst phrases. We talk as if our Heavenly Father is busted -broke and cut us off without a dime. If we give into self-pity and indulge in the luxury of misery, we banish God's riches from our life plus hinder others from entering into His provision. Learn to lavish the grace of God on the church and His blessing will come through you. If you are consciously holy there are certain things you imagine you cannot do. Love like a Christian means relying on God's provision, all the time. For more, read Oswald Chambers this month.

Habit #3 Get in the Habit of Rising to the Occasion – Ephesians 1:18-19 Habit #4 Get in the Habit of a Good Conscience – Acts 24:15-16 Habit #5 Get in the Habit of showing Christ's love to others – 2 Peter 1:7

To love like a Christian means God's love flows through your heart by the Holy Spirit. Do you know God loves you not because you're loveable but because it is His nature? Get in the habit of showing the same love to others. Let God work through your love as simple as a child's.
